Justice in the Land of Fog

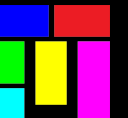

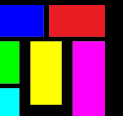

Aim at political stakeholders (Africa and Europe) to facilitate restitutions

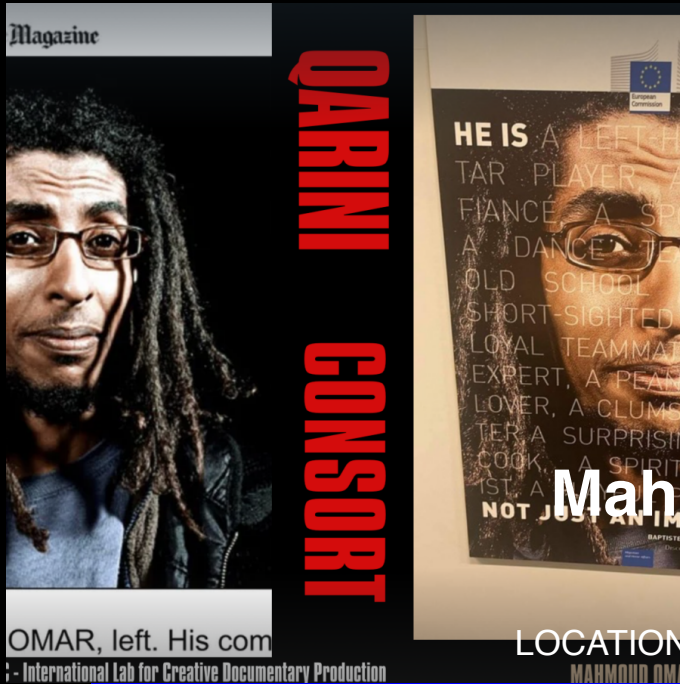
